Adding callouts to your Camtasia project is an effective tool to direct your audience's attention. Callouts include arrows, boxes, and textboxes.

Step 4a: You can also use callouts to overlay text Step 4b: Adjust when the callout fades in and out

Step 5: Sync your callout with your project by adjusting length in the timeline. Extend or shorten the length of your callout like your would edit audio

Step 1:

Open your Camtasia Project

Step 2a: Click on the Callouts tab
Step 2b: Or go to the Tools → Options

Step 3a: Click a callout that you would like to add, as well as the fill color or outline color.

Step 3b: Adjust the location and size of the callout by using the corner handles. **Step 3c:** Rotate the callout by hovering over the off centered circle.
