



Tips for Incorporating Images in Lulima Quizzes

These tips will:

- Help inspire you to find effective ways to utilize images in your Lulima Quizzes
- Provide examples of actual Lulima quizzes that are using images

Tip 1: Select large and clear images to work with.

Tip 2: Questions with images can range from simple recall (see the matching question below) to complex application (see the multiple choice question below).

Multiple Choice Question Image in Question

Based on the following figure (Miyasaka and Grunes, 1990), what is the effect of increasing root temperatures from 8 to 16 degrees C (select all that apply)?

Fig. 5. The effect of root temperature on changes in the equivalent ratio of K/(Ca + Mg) in the shoots. (Bars indicate standard errors of the mean.)

A. Equivalent ratio of K/(Ca + Mg) increases between Harvests 2 and 3

B. Equivalent ratio of K/(Ca + Mg) decreases between Harvests 2 and 4

C. Equivalent ratio of K/(Ca + Mg) is unchanged between Harvests 2 and 4

D. Equivalent ratio of K/(Ca + Mg) increases between Harvests 2 and 4

E. Equivalent ratio of K/(Ca + Mg) decreases between Harvests 2 and 3
